Description

The warm and vintage look of pewter, combined with the resistance of stainless steel, enhanced by moths, giving the Peltrox® Tarlato finish, an antiqued and intense style. The uniqueness of the moths creates a three-dimensional effect on the metal, amplifying the different shades of color between light and dark parts, as well as increasing scratch resistance even on frequently used products. The glass-line treatment makes Peltrox® suitable for kitchens, as it becomes resistant to the most common acid agents.

Cleaning and maintenance

Use a cotton or microfibre cloth dampened with water and neutral detergent, rubbing it all over the surface. Remove the remaining detergent with a clean cloth dampened only with water. Then, dry the surface. It is advisable to test any new cleaning agents on areas which are not on view

Warnings

To preserve the finish, it is advisable to avoid products containing muriatic acid, bleach or chlorine in general, as they can change the colour of the finish; deoxidising creams (like Smac), aggressive solvents such as ammonia or anti-limescale; abrasives (e.g. sponges) or products with micro particles, as they can scratch the surface. Prolonged contact with some substances generates generally light-coloured discolourations. It is advisable to rinse thoroughly in case of spillage on the surface.
